**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a meeting of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission will be held on **Thursday, March 2, 2017, at 1:00 p.m.** in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, 105 East Anapamu Street, Fourth Floor, Santa Barbara, California.

Remote Testimony is Permitted - Persons may address the Commission in person or by using the remote video testimony system in the Board of Supervisors hearing room in the Betteravia Government Center at 511 Lakeside Parkway, Santa Maria.

Disclosure of Campaign Contributions – LAFCO Commissioners are disqualified and are not able to participate in proceedings involving an “entitlement for use” if, within the 12 months preceding the LAFCO decision, the Commissioner received more than \$250 in campaign contributions from the applicant, an agent of the applicant or an financially interested person who actively supports or opposes the LAFCO decision on this matter.

Those who have made such contributions are required to disclose that fact for the official record of the proceedings. Disclosures must include the amount of the contribution and the recipient Commissioner and may be made either in writing to the Executive Officer of the Commission prior to the hearing or by an oral declaration at the time of the hearing.

The foregoing requirements are set forth in the Political Reform Act of 1974, specifically in Government Code section 84308.

**Changes of Organization and Reorganizations**

- 1) Consider recommendations regarding LAFCO application 17-02 for the Pauletto Annexation to the Goleta Sanitary District and consider adoption of a Resolution that takes the following actions:
  - a) Find the proposal to be Categorically Exempt (Class 20) from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15319;
  - b) Approve the proposal, known as the Pauletto Annexation to the Goleta Sanitary District, subject to the condition the territory shall be liable for any existing or authorized taxes, charges, fees or assessments comparable to properties presently within the District;
  - c) Find the subject territory is uninhabited, all affected landowners have given written consent and the annexing agency has given written consent to the waiver of conducting authority proceedings; and
  - d) Waive the conducting authority proceedings and direct the staff to complete the proceeding.
